



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is there a preparatory course?

Yes. There is a compulsory Spanish preparatory program.

What opportunities are available abroad? Are there any Erasmus agreements?

Both our university and our department have student and staff exchange agreements with various universities abroad. Efforts to establish new agreements are ongoing.

Are there any internship opportunities?

Yes. There is a compulsory summer internship. Students are responsible for finding an internship placement and submitting their application. Students can also undertake compulsory internships abroad through programs such as Erasmus+ Student Traineeship Mobility.

Are minor and double major options available?

Our department offers minor and double major options. The protocols are currently being finalised.

Is there a departmental library?

The Ankara University of Social Sciences library contains a variety of Spanish-language resources available to students. The Department of Spanish Translation and Interpreting is also in the process of establishing a departmental library.

Are any other languages taught besides Spanish?

Undergraduate students at our university are required to take a foreign language course outside their own department during their first four semesters. Students who complete these courses may continue to take language courses as optional subjects in the following four semesters. The current foreign language options include English, Italian, French, Russian, Chinese, Japanese, German, Arabic and Persian.
